

Educational Philosophy

The Black River Falls Board of Education recognizes that the district has an obligation to provide the best possible educational opportunities for all students attending district schools. In order to meet this obligation, the Board recognizes that:

1. The climate in the schools must be orderly, respectful of individuals and positive in nature.
2. There must be a clear understanding that attaining educational excellence is the responsibility of teachers, administrators, students, parents/guardians and the community and that cooperative efforts to attain educational excellence shall be sustained.
3. A priority focus must be on the basic skills areas.
4. Educators must commit themselves to establishing high educational standards for students and themselves.
5. A deep concern for the development of positive self-concepts and a clear belief in the value of each individual must exist.
6. Educators must provide positive role modeling and forward-looking educational leadership when working with students.
7. Educators must provide students the opportunity to develop and clarify their personal value systems through open-minded examination of the values held by this changing society.
8. Persons must realize that the school is an integral part of the community and that education is a valuable lifelong process to be engaged in by students, staff and members of the community.
