

New Board Member Orientation

The Board and administrative staff shall make every effort to assist new Board members in becoming fully informed about the function, policies, procedures and concerns of the Board.

1. New Board members shall be given any materials available relating to Board member powers and duties.
2. The district administrator shall supply materials pertinent to meetings and shall explain their use.
3. New Board members shall be invited to meet with the district administrator and the Board President to discuss Board administrative responsibilities.
4. New Board members shall be shown how to electronically access the Board's policy manual.
5. All Board members shall be strongly encouraged to participate in professional development regarding the Ho-Chunk Culture and History and other culturally responsive strategies relevant to the community of Black River Falls. Training is provided annually for new and veteran teachers; Board members will be strongly encouraged to attend during their first year of service.
6. New Board members shall be encouraged to attend inservice sessions for new Board members conducted by the Wisconsin Association of School Boards.
