

## Expectations and Outcomes

Grade Level/Course: 11-12

Content Area: Music

Unit Title	Guarantees
Unit 1: Cinematography Basics	Students will be able to identify the different instruments in the orchestra by image and sound Students will know basics of cinematography, lighting, and sound Students will know the early history of films and how music was incorporated into these films
Unit 2: Functions of Music in Movies	Students will be able to describe and identify the eleven functions of music in films Students will be able to identify and explain the importance of including folk music into films
Unit 3: Drama and Film, Film Noir	Students will be able to describe characteristics of film noir Students will be able to describe the plot structure of films and identify the components of film and music in a movie
Unit 4: What to Listen for	Students will be able to identify elements of music (tone, pitch, melody, tempo, dynamics, form, harmony, orchestration) in context of a movie soundtrack
Unit 5: Who's Who	Students will learn about careers in the film music industry Students will understand the roles of crew members in the film industry
Unit 6: Evaluating a Score	Students will learn about musical features that make soundtracks unique and independent  Students will learn about concepts to look for when evaluating a musical score
Unit 7: Planning the Score	Students will learn about the process used to plan music for a particular film  Students will learn about methods used during the scoring process to provide music for a film  Students will learn about famous film composers

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Unit 8: Synchronizing and Recording	Students will learn about the different methods used to synchronize music with the film image  Students will learn about the music recording process in a film studio
