



DISTRICT SERVICES DURING TEMPORARY FULLY VIRTUAL

Hello students and families,

We wanted to share further details on supports available to students and families during the temporary District-wide Virtual Instruction, starting November 30th.

FOOD SERVICE:

WEEKLY MEAL PICK-UP: We will be providing meals for students, assembled for a week at a time. Weekly meal pick-up will be available at the **HIGH SCHOOL** from **2pm-5:30pm** each **Monday** on weeks school is in session. Students, parents or guardians are all able to pick up meals for the household. **If you are interested in accessing weekly meals, please fill out the Google form by Friday, November 20 at 4pm to indicate the number of students we can plan for within your household.** This will begin Monday, November 30th.

MEAL ACCESS at INTERNET CAFÉ: Breakfast and Lunch will be available to students accessing the Internet Café, instead of weekly meal pick up. Grab and go breakfast will be available until 8:30am each day. The Middle and High School Cafeterias will have lunch available from 11am-Noon daily for students participating at the Café. There is no need to sign up for this at this time! This will begin on December 1st.

INTERNET CAFÉ:

During this time of Virtual Instruction, we are setting up an **Internet Cafe** for students to participate in their virtual instruction using the schools' strong Wi-Fi. We know connectivity has been a challenge due to financial resources, geographic location and household bandwidth. We are hoping this helps bridge the gap. It is **VERY** important to note the intention of this offering is for students and families to access the internet. This is **NOT** tutoring or learning support. There will be supervision by one adult for the entire cafe; they will not be able to provide learning support. Therefore, students attending in grades 6th-12th must be independent in their virtual learning. Families are welcome to access the internet cafe with their students grades 4K-5th during the hours of operation. We are running this as a drop-in offering, so students and families can attend any time during the daytime operation, no sign up is necessary.

HOURS: 8:00am-3:00pm Mon/Wed/Fri AND 8:00am-7:00pm Tues/Thursday

LOCATIONS: Middle School Commons and High School Commons

***If transportation is a barrier to accessing the Internet Café,** we will provide busing to those that need it. We will run ½ day routes or a student could utilize the internet café all day (until 3pm). Please contact the Transportation Department at (715)284-9658 by Noon on Monday, November 23rd to provide information necessary for bus route planning. Specific pick-up and drop of times will be based on routing and communicated prior to November 30th.

***If you are interested in Internet Café Evening Hours, 3:00pm-7pm Tuesday and Thursdays only, please fill out the Google form by Friday, November 20 at 4pm.** Due to extra logistics, we are asking you to sign-up for these hours, so we can plan. We will only staff this opportunity if we have enough interest.

Internet Café Student Expectations:

- Bring Required materials with you (Mask, Device, Charger, Textbooks/Workbooks/Needed Class materials, Headphones (District will provide if you do not have any)
- Be independent in virtual learning (Grades 6th-12th) Supervision is provided, not learning support.
- 4K-5th grade students have to be accompanied by an adult to help with virtual learning. (School-age children only)
- Use hand sanitizer upon entering the space
- Remain at the assigned location in cafe - Maintain 6ft distance from other guests to the cafe
- Quiet is expected - This is a learning space (Group/partner work will not be permitted, as it violates distancing efforts and quiet expectations)
